
Next up at #2, Educate tackles youth unemployment by reforming educational institutions in Africa so that students have the skills to attain further education, overcome gender inequities, start businesses, get jobs, and drive development in their communities. Educate's vision is to design solutions that measurably impact millions of youth across Africa each year.






This organization's purpose is to prepare youth in Africa with the skills to succeed in today's economy, thereby developing young leaders and entrepreneurs. Educate's model is delivered through professionally-trained teachers and empowered youth mentors. The group's goal is to make this practical, skills-based model part of the national education system wherever they work.

Moving onto #3, European Young Innovators, part of WSA Young Innovators, is a movement of young people who seek to question and improve our world. This organization believes that innovations in digital technologies have the power to create a positive impact on society. The initiative focuses on highlighting and encouraging purpose-driven digital entrepreneurship.

Originally known as the European Youth Award, it became part of World Summit Awards in 2020, offering wider opportunities for young digital entrepreneurs globally. WSA is a global community and award series that recognizes digital solutions, social entrepreneurs, start-ups, government partners, corporations, and organizations that believe in the power of innovative technology.

At #4 on our list, California Youth Connection is an organization that develops foster youth ages 14-24 so that they grow into vibrant adults who empower their communities. The goal of this organization is to transform the foster care system by bringing about changes in legislation and policy. Advocating for child welfare reform ensures that all fostered young adults are equal partners in contributing to the decisions made in their lives.

Youth-led since its inception, the group empowers its members to build leadership skills and forge supportive relationships. Members receive one-on-one support and mentoring, specialized training, and frequent opportunities to speak to policymakers, child welfare practitioners, other foster youth, and the general public. Volunteer supporters are especially important to this organization, as they provide stability, structure, transportation and food for meetings.

At #5 on our list, LivelyHoods is a notfor-profit social enterprise that creates jobs for Kenyan youth and women through the distribution of lifeimproving items such as clean-burning stoves, solar products, reading glasses, and household appliances. LivelyHoods aims to prepare their members to financially sustain themselves and their families while also inspiring hope for a bright future.

In impoverished Kenyan communities,

up to 70% of youth are jobless, with women facing additional barriers in earning an income. By offering training and job opportunities, LivelyHoods provides unemployed youth and women with opportunities to work their way out of poverty. A majority of members go on to attain employment, further their studies, or create their own businesses after they leave LivelyHoods.
