Youth Mental Health Sports Fundraiser Weez Walk 2023 Launches

Weez Walk aims to raise awareness of youth mental health and suicide prevention Sponsors include Prudential, King & Wood Mallesons, CHI Residences and Allen & Overy New features include new awards and official real-time tracking platform

(Hong Kong, 25 November 2022) The Weez Project and KELY Support Group ("KELY"), have officially launched Weez Walk 2023, a sports fundraiser to raise awareness of youth mental health and suicide prevention. The third annual fundraiser will be held from January 14 to February 19 in 2023. Participants can walk or run the 62 km Hong Kong Island Coastal Trail in one go or by stages, helping to raise awareness and funds for KELYs vital work with Hong Kong's young people.

The 2023 event aims to build on the success of Weez Walk 2022, where 720 participants raised over HK\$2.1 million. The 2023 event includes new category awards, and TRAILME, which will allow participants to track their progress and performance in real time.

Over the past year, statistics in Hong Kong have shown that on average, one young person died by suicide per week, with many more making suicide attempts. This event invites everyone to *"Be the one"* to help our society overcome the stigma around mental illness, and create a safe environment for young people to talk about their mental health challenges. Proceeds from Weez Walk 2023 will enable KELY to continue to develop its preventative mental health programmes.

Tony Bruno, Co-founder of The Weez Project said, *"I'm delighted to launch Weez Walk 2023, I'm particularly proud of the impact of this event on the mental health wellbeing of Hong Kong's young people. With the new tracking features we can accurately measure participants' performance, and I hope to see some incredible times this year!"*

Sky Siu, Executive Director of KELY Support Group said, "Losing a young person to suicide has a profound impact on us all. We all can play a vital role in the lives of young people by equipping ourselves with knowledge on how to help, communicating our care and being proactive to bring hope through action. The Weez Walk is an example, beyond raising funds for preventative programmes, participation in this meaningful event is also a healthy challenge for us to get talking about mental health issues and encouraging team collaboration and support".





Basic information of Weez Walk 2023:

Event Period:

14 January 2023 (Saturday) 00:00am - 19 February 2023 (Sunday) 11:59pm

Enrollment Period:

From now till 15 February 2023 (Wednesday) *Early bird registration lasts till 31 December, 2022 (Saturday) *Participants, who want to take up our challenge and complete for the best timing, must register by 9 February 2023 (Thursday)

Event Categories

- Timed Walk/Run: Participants can join the challenge individually or as a team, and compete for the best timing either in one go or by stages on TRAILME, our official real-time tracking platform. An e-certificate of completion with the best finishing time will be included. More details can be found on our <u>Guidelines</u>.
- Casual Walk: Participants can feel free to run / walk in any way at any time within the event period. An e-certificate of participation will be given in the end.

Fees:

- Individual (1 pax) \$375 / (early bird) \$350
- Family / non-corporate (2 4 pax) \$1,400 / (early bird) \$1,200
- Corporate (2 4 pax) \$5,000 / (early bird) Register one team and get one team free
- Students (2 4 pax) \$200 / (early bird) Register one team and get one team free
